WHAT IS A "MISSION OF MERCY" (MOM)?

It is a free adult dental clinic provided by volunteer dental professionals and volunteer staff of several hundred people.

WHAT SERVICES ARE PROVIDED?

Dental services for adult patients (19 years of age and older) include:

- •Preventive dentistry and cleaning
- Nutritional counseling
- Restorative fillings
- Extractions
- Some oral surgery
- Some root canals

All dental services will be provided by licensed dentists and hygienists.

WHAT IS THE COST?

There is no cost to the patient, no insurance form, nothing. All services are **FREE.**

WHO PAYS FOR EVERYTHING?

The dental organizations of the state raise private donations to cover all the costs. Donations may come in the form of funds; supplies; donated meals and/or snacks; furniture; badges, forms; and a variety of other support items.



WHAT IF THE PATIENT NEEDS PAIN MEDICATION OR ANTIBIOTICS?

There is a pharmacy at the event to dispense free pain medications (non-narcotic) and antibiotics as prescribed by the treating dentist.

WHAT IF A PATIENT NEEDS ADDITIONAL TREATMENT?

To assure that all patients have follow-up access, arrangements are made with local dentists to care for those individuals, if necessary.

IMPORTANT:

- There will be <u>no accommodations for children</u> at this event. Please be understanding with this policy. If you have children waiting with you in the line to enter, you will be explained this policy and you will be unable to enter the building. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
- Due to the number of patients being treated, the volunteers may not be able to provide a patient with ALL of the services they need.
- In order to insure patient privacy a <u>valid photo</u> <u>ID is required to check-in</u>.

WHAT VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED?

This clinic is made possible by volunteers. Over 500 community volunteers are needed as well as 200 dentists, dental assistants, hygienists, oral surgeons, physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses and dental students.

COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS:

You do not need any special dental or medical training in order to participate as a community volunteer. We need help with security, parking, volunteer and patient registration, meals, escorting, and more.

CLINICAL VOLUNTEERS:

We need dental and medical professionals licensed in the state of Maryland as well as dentists and hygienists from other states.
